**DAY-OF-SHOW PARKING**

**From Eastbound I-80**, take "Dixon" exit east (to right). This is "A" St. At signal at First & A Sts. (2 miles), turn right onto South First St. at the signal in the middle of town. Go 1/2 mile to the Fairgrounds on the left.

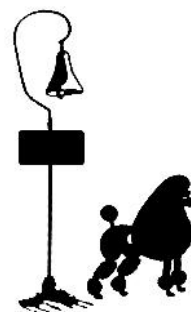

**Directions to Emergency Vet:** Take I-80 East to Hwy. 113 North. Exit at the first exit off of 113 (Hutchinson). Turn right onto Hutchinson and turn right at the second light onto LaRue. Take the first right again onto Garrod. Where Garrod ends, go straight into the parking lot for the Small Animal Clinic. The entrance for emergency is on the right side of the building. After hours there is a bell to ring to be let in.

**"Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations."**

**A judge requesting** the use of a ramp must give reasonable notice to the Show Superintendent/ Show Secretary prior to the day of the show. AKC approval is not required.

**Ramps may be used** in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where se of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)

**NO PRACTICING ALLOWED IN RINGS AT ANY TIME.**

**Dogs May Arrive** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.**

**Judges Will Not Wait For Any Dog Holding Up A Class.** Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the timely presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

**All Dogs Present** must be kept on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

**No gasoline or diesel generators** are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

**Notice - Waiver of Rights**

Please **DO NOT LEAVE ANY DOGS IN CLOSED VEHICLES.** Do not leave your dogs in unlocked cars. If any dogs are seen to be suffering from extreme temperatures where it is confined without supervision, a California Humane Officer or a Security Officer will be notified to handle the situation. Violators may be reported to the Event Committee for disciplinary action. All persons attending these events hereby waive any claim for damages against the club or its members, in the event a motor vehicle has to be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or improperly vented conditions.
