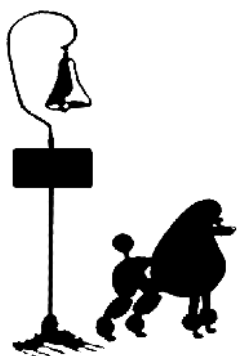

ENTRIES NOT SIGNED OR RECEIVED WITHOUT FEE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT ENTRIES CAREFULLY. THE CLUB ACCEPTS NO RESPONSIBILITIES FOR INCORRECT OR ILLEGIBLE ENTRIES. NO ENTRIES WILL BE REFUNDED FOR ANY REASON AFTER THE CLOSING DATE.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS: A recording fee of \$.50 and an Event Service Fee of \$3.00 (included in the entry fee) will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. The fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If any dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the fees are to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rules, Chapter 11, Section 2). At every licensed or member club Rally Trial, a recording fee of \$3.00 shall be required for the entry of each dog. (Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3).

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES: WEDNESDAY, APRIL 28, 2010, at 12:00 NOON, or when limits are reached prior to April 28, 2010, after which time entries will not be accepted, cancelled, substituted, or changed.

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

From North: Take Hwy 101 South to Tennant Ave. in Morgan Hill. Exit Tennant Ave. and go right. At Monterey Rd., turn left. At Watsonville Rd., turn right. Go about 4.75 miles on the left.

From South: Take 101 north to Gilroy and take the Leavesly Rd. exit. Go left on Leavesly. Turn left on Monterey Rd., then right on 1st St. Continue on 1st St. out of town, and it becomes Hwy. 152. Turn right on Watsonville Rd., and go 2.5 miles on your right.

From Watsonville: Take Hwy 152 East over Hecker Pass. At the bottom of the hill when the road straightens, turn left on Watsonville Rd., and go 2.5 miles down on your right.

Notice To Exhibitors

1. CONDITIONAL, UNSIGNED, INCOMPLETE, telephoned, or telegraphed entries cannot be accepted. Entries without fees cannot be accepted.
2. PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY or type using black or blue ink. Do not use pencil or colored ink.
3. ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse of the Official AKC entry forms are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
4. CHANGES, ADDITIONS, OR CORRECTIONS to entry forms must be received IN WRITING or by telegram prior to close of entries. Changes which are received on the telephone are not acceptable. OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such entries. The Club assumes no responsibility for a wrong entry.
5. ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, in season, excused by the Veterinarian, or Judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee.
6. THE WELL-BEING OF DOGS and participants is of paramount importance. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, extreme weather conditions (including but not limited to extreme heat, floods, hurricanes, lightning, or earthquakes), or any other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refunds of entry fee(s) will be made. **DO NOT LEAVE ANIMALS IN A HOT VEHICLE.**
7. CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY AND SCHEDULE OF JUDGING TIME will be sent to the address on the official AKC entry form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within seven (7) days of the show, the Trial Secretary should be contacted.
8. Dogs must be kept on leash except when in the judging ring.
9. Dogs not regularly entered will not be allowed within the precincts of the trial during its continuance.
10. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club and/or its Trial Secretary will not be responsible for and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agent of class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners of their agent alone are responsible for the timely presence of their dogs in the judging ring.
11. DOGS SHOULD BE AT THE TRIAL SITE one hour before their class will be judged, and may be excused from the trial after their class has been judged, if not eligible for further judging or awards.
12. THE TRIAL-GIVING CLUB, THE TRIAL SECRETARY, their agents or employes assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of their parents or guardians.
13. There will be no admission charge for spectators at this trial.
14. In case of a tie for any prize, any dog that is not present for a run-off will forfeit its rights to the prize.
15. ALL AWARDS MUST BE CLAIMED THE DAY OF TRIAL; NONE WILL BE MAILED.
16. There will be no drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the trial grounds.
17. All exhibitors who are qualified to compete for Special Awards may fill out the enclosed form and return it with entry or obtain a form the day of the Trial, provided such form is handed to the Trial Secretary **prior to the start of the class in which they are entered.**
18. Exhibitors are requested to place awnings and canopies only within designated areas and keep area clean.
